Mule & Donkey Fun Show

The fun will start at 8:00 a.m. March 27, 2010 CSU B.W. Picket Arena.

\$5.00 / class Classes will be combined or split at the discretion of the committee. Games will be arranged so that all may participate. For planning purposes please RSVP as soon as possible.

- 1 Trail/Obstacle – The trail course will be open upon completion of the Pack, Load & Appointments class and until 11:30 am. One pass per animal. May ride or be in-hand. (halter & Lead rope only required for in-hand)
- 2 Pack, Load & Appointments – 1 Packer, 1 mule on the west side of the arena. Packer leads the mule to the east side; saddles & packs the camp, loads the pack and ties a recognized hitch (i.e., diamond, DD, etc.), then leads the loaded mule thru an obstacle course. Judged and timed.
- 3 Reinsmanship Driving (Single) Not VSE
- 4 Reinsmanship Driving (Single) VSE
- 5 Reinsmanship Driving (Hitch)
- 6 Green Mule or Donkey Driving (Single)
- 7 Drive & Ride – To be shown in harness & then ridden by the same exhibitor. 2 assistants may be used during the tack change.
- 8 Green Mule or Donkey Riding (Walk/Trot only)
- 9 Lead Line/Simon Says
- 10 Coon Jumping (All sizes – Will split as required)

Lunch Break – Back Country Horsemen Presentation: “Leaving No Trace”

- 11 Packers Scramble Class – 2 Packers, 3 mules. 1 Packer and mules at west side of arena, the 2nd packer at “camp”. At GO the camp packer gets up and packs camp stuff (to be furnished!). All saddles will be at “camp”. The packer with the mules leads them to camp. The packers saddle and pack the mules (2 saddle mules and one pack mule). Then the team rides the obstacle course to the finish line. Timed. - Point faults for each non-completed obstacle.
- 12 Cloverleaf Barrels – Ride, Drive, Packers (Ride one, lead one), Youth - Drivers & Packers will trot only!
- 13 Dual Barrels (Pantyhose race)
- 14 Egg & Spoon – Ride, drive or lead – Drivers will be required to have a “helper” to carry the egg & spoon.
- 15 Run-Ride-Lead
- 16 Pole Bending – Ride, drive or lead
- 17 Pylon Alley – Ride, drive or lead
- 18 Log Skid – VSE, single or teams
- 19 Diaper Race
